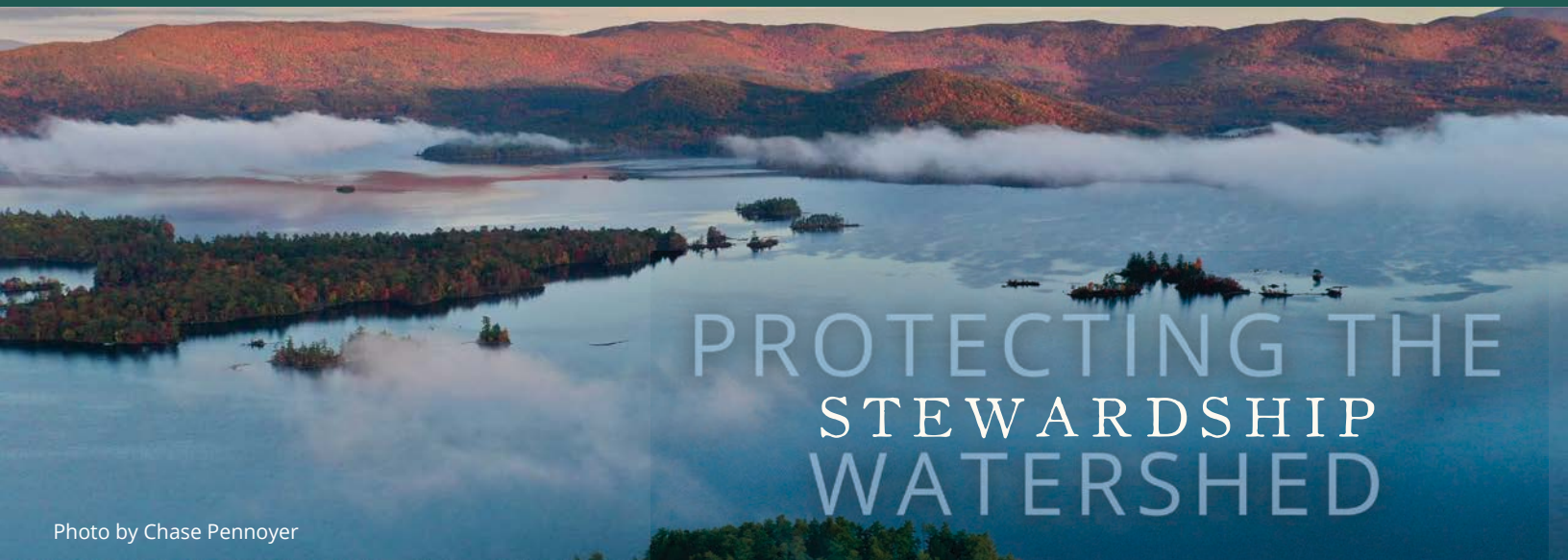

The Dot Banks Nature Trail at Tompkins Preserve

In the summer of 2020, SLCS staff and volunteers built a nature trail to Lost Lake in Sandwich with the hope of encouraging people to enjoy nature while respecting wildlife. Lost Lake and its wetlands lie on the north side of Squam Lake in what is referred to as the Upper Asquam Preserve.

The Dot Banks Nature Trail winds across three properties that are managed in partnership with the Lakes Region Conservation Trust. The trail's namesake, Dot Banks, was an avid nature and wildlife lover. She worked as a raptor rehabilitator and shared her love for wildlife with everyone she met. The Upper Asquam Preserve is home to many creatures, including long-tailed weasels, bears, turkeys, porcupines, deer, hawks, owls, moose, beavers, otters, songbirds, and herons.

The Dot Banks Nature Trail is open year-round. While we love dogs too, we ask that you leave them home when using this special trail in order to preserve the wildlife habitat.

Squam stargazers admired the clear night sky on the first annual *Night With the Stars* in August. Join the celebration this year on August 14, 2021.

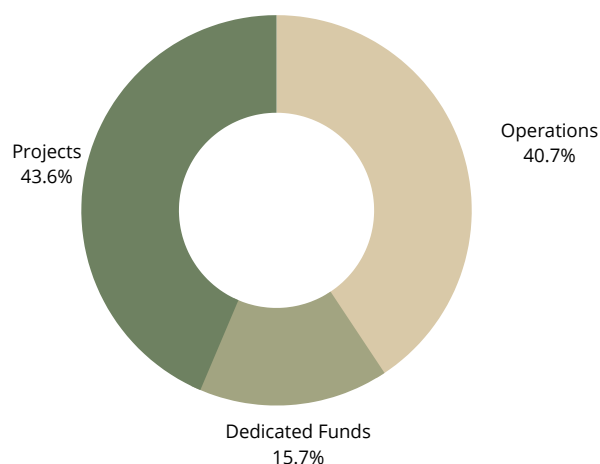
The SLCS volunteer monitoring team gathered at Doublehead Preserve in September for their annual appreciation gathering.

2020 Financial Summary

Financially, SLCS weathered 2020 in excellent shape thanks to the continued support of you, our members. We came just short of meeting a lofty \$445,000 fundraising goal and stayed within budget on expenses. We are particularly pleased that this result was achieved without federal support under the Paycheck Protection Program. We ended 2020 with \$255,488 in Operating Cash, slightly over our target of \$250,000.
