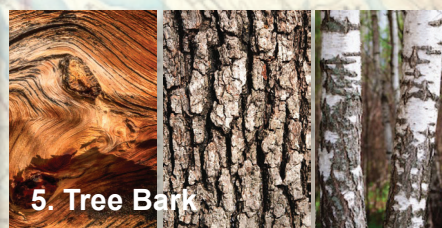
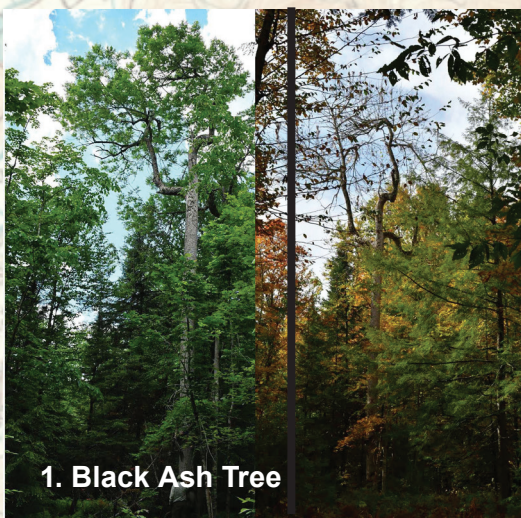

1. The now de-throned NH State Champion Black Ash Tree, which succumbed to the Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) in 2020.
 - We do not permit dogs on this trail so wildlife remains undisturbed
2. Footbridge over Burrows Brook.
 - Stay on the paths
3. Don't forget to write in the journal on the bench.
 - Carry in-Carry out (leave no trace)
3. Listen for bird song (can you copy it?)
 - Bring family and/or friends
4. Find and identify any animal scat?
 - Take pictures. Post to your favorite social media and tag Squam Lakes Conservation Society at #squamlakesconservationsociety on Instagram
5. Identify 3 kinds of trees by their bark
6. Find and identify 3 animal tracks
7. Identify an animal den/burrow. Who do you think is living there?
 - **Go to our website foreversquam.org for maps, directions and more scavenger hunts**
8. A tree that a beaver has been chewing on.
9. Find Lost Lake.
