

Insect Galls. Unusual growths on plants

- Glacial Erratics. Find a giant rock that looks like it shouldn't be there.
- 3. A Snag. A dead tree that is still standing and may be home to wildlife. Observe quietly to see if someone is living there.
- Find and identify 3 animal tracks.
- 5. Identify 3 kinds of trees by their bark.
- 6. Find a vernal pool. Who's living there?
- 7. Listen for a bird song (can you copy it?)
- 8. Can you identify any bodies of water, islands or mountains in the view?
- 9. Did you make it to the North Peak?
